

Who is Agares?

Duke of the Eastern Powers, Commander of Momentum, Restorer of Lost Dominion

Initiation Structure and Overview

This lesson opens your formal alignment with Agares—the Infernal Duke who commands the winds of the East, governs the flow of time and territory, and walks with those who reclaim what was stolen, abandoned, or buried. As the first of ten lessons in this remote 21-day initiation, what you receive here is not simply knowledge—it is the beginning of spiritual recognition. You are not learning about Agares. You are *being seen* by him.

Over the next 21 days, you will engage in a daily ritual: reciting a sacred four-word mantra in Rakh Enagh three times while gazing into Agares's sigil. If even one day is missed, the entire cycle must begin again. This is not about punishment—it is spiritual architecture. Each repetition, each moment of focus, constructs an energetic channel through which his current flows. Alongside your work, seven remote rituals will be performed by the Terra Incognita Coven to install the current in your field, reinforce it, and seal it permanently into your energetic infrastructure.

But before you recite the first word, you must understand who is listening.

Who is Agares?

Agares is a Duke in the hierarchy of spirits known as the Goetia—an ancient catalog of intelligences not of light nor shadow, but of truth and power. He is ranked as the second spirit in the *Ars Goetia*, holding command over 31 legions, and is traditionally associated with the East: the direction of sunrise, of breath, of motion, and of all beginnings. He appears mounted on a crocodile, bearing a hawk on his

fist or accompanied by swift hounds, symbols of dominion over land, speed, and command.

But to the initiate, Agares is far more than a title or form. He is **movement embodied**. His domain is speed—not chaos, but calculated acceleration. He governs the ability to reverse inertia, to retrieve what has been lost, and to install presence where there was once exile.

He is the one who teaches languages—not only of nations, but of spirits, systems, and power. He sharpens the tongue and grants it command. His influence restores eloquence to the speechless and dominion to the displaced. He does not comfort. He *activates*.

Agares in the Hidden World

While many see Agares only through the lens of old grimoires, initiates of the inner path know him differently: as the *Commandant of Territory*. This territory may be physical—such as land, property, contracts, or space—but it is just as often spiritual: your name, your time, your narrative, your authority.

When you walk with Agares:

- You no longer delay what must be done.
- You speak without stuttering—energetically, verbally, legally.
- You recover what slipped from your grip.
- You cross thresholds that were once closed.
- You stand where you once bowed.

He does not give power. He clears the ground so you can stand in it.

The Function of Movement

Agares governs **kinetic command**—the power to move without confusion. His current clears stagnation, slowness, spiritual distraction, and ancestral weight. He presses the body forward, reawakens the fire in the feet, and adjusts your timeline so that what was meant to unfold—*does*.

His is not movement without direction. It is purpose in motion. Many initiates find that after even the first week of alignment, they:

- Change jobs or locations
- Speak truths long withheld
- Reclaim languages or skills once abandoned
- Experience sudden closure of unresolved cycles
- Step forward into arenas they feared to enter

This is not coincidence. It is correction.

Agares and Language

In classical grimoires, Agares is said to “teach languages instantly.” But this is not mere translation of vocabulary—it is **dominion over expression**.

He governs:

- Foreign language fluency
- Eloquence in speech and writing
- Authority in verbal delivery
- Magical scripting and sigil grammar
- Word-as-command protocols

To speak under Agares's current is to **carry weight with your words**. You stop asking. You begin declaring.

Those who fear speaking truth, or whose voices have been energetically suppressed, find this current both liberating and exacting. Under Agares, you no longer get to hide behind silence.

Agares and Return

One of the most misunderstood functions of Agares is his power of **return**. He retrieves—not only objects or opportunities, but timelines, memories, and dignity.

His current specializes in:

- Reversing delays
- Reclaiming titles, homes, or spaces
- Restoring ancestral momentum

- Calling back spiritual or financial inheritances
- Realigning you with a version of yourself before collapse

This power is not nostalgic. It is strategic. It retrieves not to return you to the past—but to give you the tools you abandoned when you were made small.

Agares and the East

As a Duke of the East, Agares governs beginnings, initiations, portals, and winds of change. In ritual, East is the gate of breath, clarity, momentum, and word. He rides not toward war, but toward rebalancing. He does not destroy—he rearranges.

Those aligned with him often feel drawn to:

- Open fields, wind, desert, or sunrise
- Movement-based ritual (walking, marching, dancing)
- Language study or linguistic channeling
- Maps, borders, and geopolitics
- Recovery of scattered life fragments

If you've ever felt that your life *could have gone another way*, Agares is the force that places you back on that path—not as fantasy, but as reclamation.

How Agares Appears

Some initiates see him as a desert warrior in white cloth, bearing a scroll and a sabre. Others feel him as wind moving through bones, or a word that enters the mouth uninvited but undeniable. You may dream of mounted spirits, directional banners, foreign alphabets, windstorms, or heat rising in your chest.

He does not comfort. He *moves*.

You will not always feel his presence—but you will notice your environment, body, and timeline shift in response.

Signs Agares Is Already Calling You

- Frustration with blocked plans or bureaucratic delays
- Dreams involving wind, deserts, horses, or foreign words
- Sudden urge to reclaim lost skills or resume forgotten projects
- Encounters with linguistic symbols or old contracts
- Impulses to walk, travel, or run
- Repeated appearances of the word “East,” directional symbols, or messengers
- Anxiety turning into motion, fear transmuting into speech
- A sense that *you’re late*, but you *could still arrive*

If you feel these now, the current is already opening. This lesson is simply your conscious entry.

Invocation of Recognition

Stand up. Place your dominant hand over your chest. Close your eyes. Say aloud:

*“Agares of the East,
I stand where I once waited.
I move where I once fell.
Let your wind enter.
Let my path rise.”*

Breathe. Let heat gather. Do not question it.

You are not requesting permission. You are activating remembrance.

The Path Has Begun

With this lesson complete, your awareness is aligned. The sigil will now begin to speak to you. The mantra will not only echo—it will *ignite*. Each repetition in the coming days is a hammer stroke. Each ritual performed by the Terra Incognita Masters is a fortress stone.

You are not preparing. You are walking.
