Haures (Hauras) — The Fierce Protector and Revelation Spirit

Rank: Duke

Haures is a fierce spirit who embodies protective fire and revelation. He shields the practitioner from harm while illuminating hidden threats or spiritual dangers. Haures is particularly effective in ritual settings requiring boldness and confrontation of malevolent forces.

Halphas — The Guardian of Fortifications and Defensive Magic

Rank: Earl

Role: Commands legions for defense; protects strongholds and wards off enemies; expert in defense strategies.

Halphas is a master of fortification, both physical and spiritual. When you need to build strong energetic walls around your home or spirit, Halphas lends his expertise. His disciplined nature assists in organizing protection magic systematically.

Raum — The Spirit of Confiscation and Energetic Shielding

Rank: Earl

Role: Steals secrets from enemies; breaks down barriers; protects against spiritual theft and harm.

Raum is adept at dismantling enemy plans and energetically shielding the practitioner from hidden attacks. His skill in taking away harmful energies makes him a versatile ally in protection and justice.

Marax (Morax) — Protector and Master of Knowledge and Healing

Rank: Earl

Role: Grants knowledge of herbs and stones; protects through wisdom and healing; shields against unseen threats.

Marax combines protection with healing and wisdom, offering a holistic approach to safeguarding body and spirit. His guidance can enhance protective workings by integrating natural magics.

Glasya-Labolas — The Justice Enforcer and Protector Against Enemies

Rank: President

Role: Expert in uncovering enemies; protects from harm and danger; teaches strategic defense and legal magic.

Glasya-Labolas is a complex spirit of justice, with a reputation as both a protector and a bringer of retribution. His expertise in social and legal justice makes him a favored spirit for rituals addressing slander, enemies, and protection of reputation.

Astaroth — Gatekeeper of Ancient Knowledge and Social Justice

Rank: Duke

Role: Keeper of secrets and justice; helps in negotiations and legal matters; empowers spiritual sovereignty.

Astaroth offers wisdom for navigating social justice and legal complexities. Invoking him in protection and justice workings provides clarity, power, and authority.

Malphas — Architect of Defense and Curse Reversal

Rank: President

Role: Constructs fortresses and defensive barriers; breaks hexes and curses; reveals enemy plans.

Malphas is the master architect of infernal protection. His energy is ideal for building impenetrable spiritual defenses and undoing malice aimed at the practitioner.

Buer — Healer and Protector Through Restoration

Rank: President

- **Protection against deception and betrayal:** Andromalius, Orobas, Glasya-Labolas
- **Physical and energetic shielding:** Halphas, Malphas, Raum
- **Revealing hidden dangers and enemy plans:** Haures, Raum, Malphas
- **Healing and restoring from spiritual harm:** Buer, Marax
- **Legal and social justice empowerment:** Astaroth, Glasya-Labolas

Understanding these nuances allows you to tailor rituals precisely, honor spirits properly, and work effectively.
