

Who Is Shax?

Shax, also known in older texts as Chax or Scox, is the 44th spirit of the Ars Goetia, holding the title of **Great Duke**. His nature has always puzzled and fascinated demonologists, for he is neither purely a deceiver nor entirely a protector. He governs a realm that is not built of form, but of *absence* — an echo, a veil, a redirection.

Manifestations of His Presence

Those attuned to Shax often sense his energy through:

Objects associated with him include:
