It erodes the psychic hooks of the past, severs trauma bonds, and cloaks the wearer in energetic opacity when walking through hostile environments—physical or astral.

- When navigating toxic relationships or spiritual interference
- During rituals of uncrossing, decay, or emotional release
- As a protective cloak when traveling, journeying, or dreaming

The Vepar Ring - Anchor of Emotional Rot and Psychic Boundaries
