They are mirrors of his trifold nature: *seer of what was, is, and shall be*.

The first face looks to the past, deciphering karmic patterns, ancestral currents, and forgotten truths that still move within your blood.

The second face stares directly into the present moment — the most dangerous and

powerful of times, where choices are made, and paths split.

The third turns to the future — not to predict it passively, but to empower the initiate to *shape* it through clarity, sovereignty, and attuned will.

Balam is a *guardian of time*, not in the sense of hours and minutes, but in the way a guardian protects the coherence of a soul's unfolding. His three faces mean this: no lie survives his sight. No deception escapes his awareness.

During these days, the masters of Terra Incognita Coven will invoke Balam in your name seven times. These rituals — performed remotely — open the great

watchtower of his current to you, sealing you in his protective gaze.

You will be changed.

Once attuned to Balam, his presence does not fade. He becomes part of your field. His vision becomes your instinct. His protection becomes a silent guard walking with you always.

Prepare Yourself for What Comes Next

This first lesson has opened the gate to Balam's world. You now know who he is: the triple-faced seer, the fiery guardian, the keeper of hidden thresholds. But knowing is not enough. You must *embody* what you know.
