The 72 Demons of the Ars Goetia each have distinct preferences when it comes to offerings, including specific candle colors and incense types that align with their energies. **Bael**, the first spirit of the Goetia, rules over invisibility and strategic influence. His preferred candle color is **black**, symbolizing the concealment and authority he bestows. His favored incense is **dragon's blood**, a powerful enhancer for commanding presence.

**Agares**, who aids in language mastery and swift action, resonates with **green** candles, signifying growth and acceleration. **Sandalwood** incense appeals to his essence, grounding the user in wisdom.

**Vassago**, known for uncovering the past and revealing the future, favors **blue** candles, symbolizing insight and clarity. His chosen incense is **myrrh**, a sacred scent used for divination.

**Samigina**, the teacher of lost wisdom and artistry, prefers **purple** candles, representing the deep mysteries he governs. His incense of choice is **storax**, which enhances learning and concentration.

**Marbas**, the healer and giver of mechanical knowledge, aligns with **yellow** candles, radiating intellectual energy and health. His preferred incense is **frankincense**, known for

**Paimon**, the grand teacher of hidden knowledge and leadership, demands **gold** candles, reflecting his regal presence. His incense is **frankincense and cinnamon**, a combination befitting his commanding wisdom.

**Buer**, known for healing and philosophy, resonates with **white** candles, representing purity of mind and body. His favored incense is **rosemary**, a powerful cleanser for both the spirit and intellect.

**Gusion**, the revealer of destiny, prefers **silver** candles, illuminating his role in uncovering truth. **Sage** incense aids in his clarity-bringing work.

**Zepar**, the master of love and fidelity, prefers **crimson** candles, deepening emotional

intensity. His incense is **ylang-ylang**, heightening passion and commitment.

**Botis**, the revealer of past and future mistakes, is best approached with **indigo** candles, representing introspection. **Bay leaf** incense enhances his ability to bring hidden matters to light.

**Bathin**, who guides those seeking travel and change, resonates with **light brown** candles, reflecting movement and grounding. His incense of choice is **pine**, symbolizing fresh beginnings.

**Sallos**, the bringer of love and reconciliation, prefers **coral** candles, merging affection with confidence. His favored incense is **vanilla**, a sweet yet powerful force in relationships.

**Purson**, the ruler of hidden treasures and divination, aligns with **bronze** candles, exuding mystery and wealth. His incense is **copal**, often used for deep spiritual insights.

Orobas, a loyal protector and revealer of truth, aligns with royal blue candles, symbolizing

These candle colors and incenses are the best options for working with the 72 demons of the Ars Goetia, carefully aligned with their individual energies to enhance rituals and connections. However, some of these materials can be difficult to find, especially more obscure candle colors like chameleon or bronze, and incenses such as oakmoss or blue lotus. Fortunately, there are universal alternatives that work effectively with the majority of demons, making ritual preparation much easier. Five candle colors that are widely available and adaptable for most demons are **black**, **white**, **red**, **blue**, **and gold**, as they represent power, clarity, passion, wisdom, and divine authority, respectively. Similarly, five easily accessible incenses that can be used for general demon work are **frankincense**, **myrrh**, **sandalwood**, **dragon's blood**, **and cinnamon**, as they enhance energy, communication, protection, and manifestation, ensuring a strong connection to the infernal forces.

Each of these demons has a unique essence, and their preferred candle colors and incenses act as keys to aligning with their power. By using the right offerings, practitioners can forge a stronger bond with these powerful entities, gaining insights, protection, and transformation along their spiritual path.
